Ocean Plan Amendment Issue 4 Desalination Facilities and Brine Disposal

- Desalination brine and salinity objective was covered at the 2007 Ocean Plan Amendment scoping meeting
- Triennial Review Workplan adopted on March 15, 2011
 - Desalination Facilities and Brine Disposal amendment, very high priority, targeted for 2012

Desalination Facilities & Brine Disposal

- Preliminary Staff Recommendation (April 18, 2011 Stakeholder Mtg):
 - Narrative water quality objective: Salinity not to exceed 10% of natural background
 - Implementation compliance at edge of ZID
 - Intakes prevent or minimize Impingement and Entrainment
 - prohibit intakes from impaired enclosed bays for ocean disposal

Three Studies to Inform Policy: Updates

- Intake Impacts and Mitigation "Expert Review Panel II" - will also address interim mitigation issues for OTC Policy
- Brine Toxicity (laboratory)
- Brine Disposal Expert Panel (Modeling)

Process

- Second Scoping Meeting (to address intakes, enclosed bay discharges)
- Complete Studies (March 2012)
- Board level workshop
- Prepare Draft Substitute Environmental Document and Draft Amendments
 - Ocean Plan
 - Enclosed Bays and Estuaries Plan
- Public Hearing
- Response to Public Comments
- Consideration for Adoption at a State Board Meeting before end of 2012
