



Size and Scope - Fiscal Condition


- Fee based program
 - Laboratory Accreditation Fund
- ▶ 3.3 Million Budget
 - Revenue 2.2 Million
 - Deficit of 1.5 Million
- Water Board Fee Branch lead effort to restructure fees
- Currently Fees are as follows:
- 1003 Base fee + #of FoTs x 452 = Total Fee

Certifying Laboratories

Application Processes

- New Application
 - Require inspection
- Renewal Application
 - Submit every 2 years
 - Waive inspection if not a threat to public health
- Amendment Application
 - Adding FoT or method
 - Requires inspection
- Out-of-State Application
 - Require inspection (new)
 - Existing certification based on status of other out-ofstate certifications

Certification/Inspection/Fees Timeline



Backlog Process

- Priorities based on:
 - Labs that test for drinking water (FOT 101–105)
 - How long inspection has needed to be done
- Some laboratories backlogged since 2008

Monitor and Enforce

Monitor

- Review PTs annually
- Comprehensive review of all Applications (QA Manual)

Enforce

- Exercise enforcement tools in regulations
- Unannounced inspections
- Utilize Office of Enforcement expertise
