#### Establish a Management System

- Purchased 17011/TNI
- Gap Analysis
  - Existing regulations vs. draft regulations vs.
     17011 vs. USEPA Manual for the certification of laboratories analyzing
- 17011 requires operational processes (SOPs)
- Internal reviews to assess performance

# Adopt laboratory standards

- Purchased TNI/17025
- Thoughtful discussion on ERP report options
- Gap analysis
  - Existing regulations vs. draft regulations vs. 17025 vs. TNI
- Before any standard is chosen
  - Robust Stakeholders process
  - Outreach, education, compliance assistance

#### Ensure relevant analytical methods

- Rewrite regulations
- Organizing regular meetings with regulatory agency partners / SAC
  - Immediate goals
    - Update ELAP activities
    - Compile and publish a list of all approved methods
    - Advertise list (webpage, email subscription)

## **Expand Resources**

- 27 budgeted positions, 3 vacancies
- Reorganized ELAP, created a Proficiency Testing Unit
- Adjusting fees to fully support a whole program
- Recently completed training (USEPA CO, FDA pesticide residue, microbiology hands-on, organic/inorganic chemistry, CalEPA Inspector Academy, communication with tact & professionalism
- Upcoming training: radiochemistry, environmental crimes, fraud, TNI/17025 Auditor training
- Reviewed Pennsylvania Auditor Training Program

#### **Enhance Communication**

- Strategic Communications Action Plan (SCAP) living document
- Staff upcoming training: Communications with tact and professionalism, technical writing, regular all staff meetings on professionalism
- Laboratory Community: SAC regular meetings in lieu of permanent ELTAC, email messages (every week), webpage updates, post cards, workshops
- State Agency Partners: Regular meetings, Doodle Poll
- Met with Department Pesticide Regulation
- USEPA approval in writing to use other AB/State Certifications
  - Posted to webpage, email message

## ELTAC role in ERP report

- Critical
- Vetting technical and scientific issues
  - Establish a management system provide technical advice
  - Adopt laboratory accreditation standards consult feasibility of options
  - Ensure relevant analytical methods technical consult on methods
  - Expand resources ELTAC laboratory training ground, resources other training opportunities
  - Enhance communications always comment on SCAP, review email messages, official announcements, edit/review survey monkey
- Interim:
  - SAC regular meetings
  - 2<sup>nd</sup> Draft By-laws
