### **BACKGROUND**

- The Eastern San Joaquin River (ESJ) watershed growers were issued a waste discharge permit by the Regional Board in 2012
  - The permit included a surface water monitoring program
- Adequacy of the monitoring program was challenged by several groups
  - The State Water Board recognized some merits in the petition
  - They ordered the Regional Board to convene a panel of experts to review adequacy of the monitoring program
- This is the third (and final) meeting of that Review Panel

### **ESJ PANEL MEETING GOALS**

- The first meeting (three days in January) was to provide the Panel with background information
  - Included a field trip
- Second meeting focused on answering questions posed by the Panel
  - Three day meeting in August via Zoom
  - Goal was for the Panel to obtain the information they needed to complete their report
- This meeting is for the Panel to receive feedback on their draft report
  - They would like to hear whether the report is clear, or how it could be made more clear
  - They also want to hear if you have any additional factual information that should cause them to reconsider any of their recommendations
