

Concerns: differentiate "brines"

- Recycled wastewater vs cooling towers vs groundwater desalters vs ocean desalination
- Dissolved solids by the numbers



- Treated wastewater
 - Low TDS loads and managed contaminants

Concerns: support recycling

- OCSD has 30+ years of experience
 - Seawater intrusion barrier in 1975
 - Groundwater replenishment started in 2008
 - Now reclaiming 70 mgd
 - Plans for reclaiming 100 mgd by 2014
- SWRCB Recycled Water Policy
 - Increase use of recycled water over 2002 levels by 1 million acre-ft by 2020
 - Increase by 2 million acre-ft by 2030.

Ideas for Discussion

- Panel should distinguish between the different "brine" discharges
 - Desalination plants
 - Groundwater desalting facilities
 - Power generating cooling stations
 - Water recycling projects
- State should not impinge on water recycling opportunities
 - Combined discharges that meet NPDES standards should be approved

Ideas for Discussion

- Consider existing regulations and water recycling policy
 - Wastewater treatment plants are regulated by NPDES permits
 - Discharge limits are set for mass loads
