ENDEMIC VS. PANDEMIC

SCCWRP has mostly returned to normal operation

- Averaging about 60% of staff on site
- Travel is approaching pre-COVID levels
- Hosting large meetings

However, we take precautions

- Visitors require proof of vaccination
- Conduct on-site testing for large meetings

Also provide staff flexibility

- Staff can work from home two days a week
- Can also stay home if we have on site meetings
- Proven they can work effectively from home



BIGHT'23

- Bight Regional Monitoring is one of our flagship programs
 - Nearly 100 organizations collaborate to assess condition of the SoCal Bight
- We will hold our Bight'23 kickoff meeting on Sept 22
 - Kickoff is where we develop our study elements and monitoring questions
- This will be an in-person meeting
 - Too much interaction among too many people to hold it virtually
 - We will provide listening options for plenary sessions and for three breakout groups
- Three steps to increase comfort with in-person meeting
 - Require proof of vaccination
 - Proof of negative COVID antigen test (at home or on-site) within 24 hours of meeting
 - Masking requested while in the building; food served outside

PREMEETING ACTIVITIES

- Primary engine for Bight is SCCWRP's member agencies
 - Bight '23 starts with a shared vision among our member agencies
 - We walk into the Kickoff with that vision looking for additional support and add-ons
- Bight pre-planning began with CTAG and Commission presentations on outcomes and recommendations from Bight '18
- Karen McLaughlin has met with representatives from each agency to discuss potential Bight elements
- Karen will meet next with member agency specialists for each element
 - The outcome of those meetings will be the strawman we use to stimulate discussion at the Kickoff meeting
